

CPCCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)

Ability to read and interpret common safety signs and documentation

Who is this Course for?

This course is designed for those entering the construction industry.

Delivery method:

This course is delivered face-to-face at the Gladstone Training Services,

1 Manning St South Gladstone QLD in both classroom and simulated workplace areas.

Please Note: In Queensland, a Construction Induction Card, otherwise known as a White Card must be conducted face-to-face (not online) unless you are exempt. An exemption applies allowing candidates whose residential address is further than 100 kilometres away from the nearest RTO delivering face to face white card training, to complete the white card training via online delivery.

Course outline:

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work. The unit requires the person to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.

Course Outcomes:

Successful completion of training and assessment will result in a QLD White Card and Statement of Attainment from Gladstone Training Services (RTO # _____).
